Using Interstate 5: From the SOUTH: Use Exit 111, Lincoln Ave, Map C, Turn LEFT onto Lincoln, turn RIGHT at Beach BI, turn LEFT at Crescent, Hotel on Right. To go home, Reverse and enter Freeway in Left Lane at Map Point Z.
